



KIDZMANIA was held on Saturday, October 15th from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. at the Crossroads Mall, Fort Dodge, Iowa. The event featured 62 booths, stage performances and 6 costumed characters including: The Dark Knight and Wonder Woman from the Iowa League of Heroes, Elsa and Anna from Little Princess Parties, Iowa State's Cy the Cyclone and Herky the Hawkeye from the University of Iowa. Children registered in five locations. Upon the close of KIDZMANIA, 1,226 children from 599 families had registered. It is estimated that the total attendance was over 1,800.

Child Attendance by County














Number of Families by Race/Ethnicity



THE RESULTS:

From the registrations gathered prizes were awarded and electronic surveys were sent out to those that included an email address on their registration slip. An email went out to 341 participants requesting that they take a short survey.




Of the 341 emails sent, 286 were valid email addresses. Of those emails:

- 79 people opened the email;
- 30 people started the survey; and
- 28 people completed the survey.

Of the survey respondents:


• 25 were female, 3 were male







*How did you learn about KIDZMANIA?







*By attending KIDZMANIA, did you learn about or learn more about any of the community programs, resources and businesses that were there?




*Have you contacted, enrolled, participated or done business with any of the organizations that had booths at KIDZMANIA?

*How do you think KIDZMANIA could be improved?


- The point is to get people to come so not sure how much you can change the crowds. What a great event for the community.

- A few more attractions for little tykes.




*How do you think KIDZMANIA could be improved? (Continued)
